Dear Commissioners and Staff:

By letter dated December 21, 2001, the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) submitted an application to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a 10 CFR 72 site-specific license to build and operate an independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) at the Diablo Canyon Power Plant (DCPP) site. The application included a Safety Analysis Report, Environmental Report, and other required documents in accordance with 10 CFR 72.

By letter dated August 29, 2002, the NRC staff requested additional information needed to continue their review of the Diablo Canyon ISFSI License Application.

PG&E's response to the request for additional information is included in Enclosure 1. A list of attachments is contained in Enclosure 2 followed by the attachments. A list of figures is contained in Enclosure 3 followed by the figures. Amendment 1 to the Diablo Canyon Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation License Application was submitted in PG&E Letter DIL-02-010, dated October 15, 2002. Amendment 1 contains material responding to items contained in Enclosure 1. Holtec proprietary documents referenced in Enclosure 1 were submitted in PG&E Letter DIL-02-011, dated October 15, 2002.



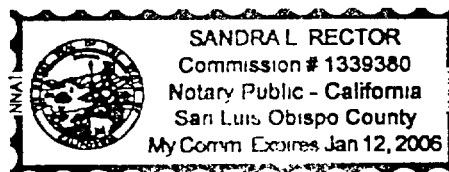
