19 [PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR VALUATION OF
20 CLAIM FOR FEASIBILITY PURPOSES (SAMUEL ANDERSON, CLAIM NO. 178)

22 On October 2, 2002, the motion by Pacific Gas and Electric Company, debtor and
23 debtor in possession in this Chapter 11 case ("PG&E" or the "Debtor"), for an order valuing
24 certain Employment Claims solely for purposes of determining the feasibility of the Plan of
25 Reorganization Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code for Pacific Gas & Electric
26 Company (dated April 19, 2002) filed by PG&E and PG&E Corporation on March 7, 2002
27 (the "PG&E Plan") came on regularly for hearing before the Court. Ethan P. Schulman of
28 Howard, Rice, Nemerovski, Canady, Falk & Rabkin, A Professional Corporation, appeared

1 for the Debtor; no appearance was made on behalf of or opposition filed by the Claimant,
2 Samuel Anderson (Claim No. 178), or by any other party.

3 Accordingly, and for the reasons stated by the Court on the record of the hearing,
4 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

5 The Claim of Samuel Anderson, Proof of Claim No. 178, in the amount of \$10
6 million for "wrongful termination," shall be valued at zero for purposes of determining the
7 financial feasibility of the PG&E Plan. This valuation shall be for feasibility purposes only,
8 shall not determine or affect the allowance of the Claim, and shall not be binding on or
9 admissible in the Superior Court in which the Litigation is pending.
