I. INTRODUCTION

This procedure describes the process to be followed to update the "List of Governors' Designees Receiving Advance Notification of Transportation of Nuclear Waste."

II. OBJECTIVE

To ensure that the "List of Governors' Designees Receiving Advance Notification of Transportation of Nuclear Waste" is published annually in the *Federal Register* (FR) on or about June 30 to reflect any changes in information.

III. BACKGROUND

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) regulations in 10 CFR Parts 71 and 73 require advance notification to Governors or their designees by NRC licensees prior to transportation of certain shipments of nuclear waste and spent fuel. The advance notification covered in Part 73 is for spent nuclear reactor fuel shipments and the notification for Part 71 is for large quantity shipments of radioactive waste (and spent nuclear reactor fuel not covered under Part 73). NRC regulations require the list of the names and mailing addresses of the Governors' designees receiving advance notification of these shipments to be annually updated and published in the FR on or about June 30 to reflect any changes in information. The Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) is assigned the responsibility to update this list and to ensure publication in the FR.

IV. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. The Director, STP, has overall responsibility for the review and approval of the FR notice, which includes the updated list of Governors' designees, and the NRC letter requesting modifications or updated information.
- b. The Senior Intergovernmental Program Analyst (SIPA), STP, prepares the NRC letter requesting modifications or updated information, updates the list of Governors' designees and prepares the FR notice, which includes the updated list of Governors' designees.

V. GUIDANCE

a. In the late February/early March of every year, the SIPA will prepare a letter, which will include the list of Governors' designees from the previous year, to the Governors' designees requesting modifications or updated information (see Appendix A). The letter should request changes in designee or information changes by June 1.

b. Based on changes received in response to the letter mentioned in V. a. (above), the SIPA will update the list of Governors' designees and prepare a revised FR notice. The revised FR notice will be provided by STP to the Rules and Directives Branch of the Office of Administration for publication (see Appendix B). The SIPA will ensure that sufficient time is allowed for review and approval of the draft FR notice by STP management in time for publication in the FR on or about June 30. The SIPA will coordinate with the Rules and Directives Branch to ensure publication in the FR on or about June 30.

I have enclosed a copy of the applicable portions of the regulations for your information. Also enclosed is a copy of NUREG-0794 "Protection of Unclassified Safeguards Information" which is intended to assist persons who possess Safeguards Information in establishing an information protection system that satisfies the specific requirements of Section 73.21 of Part 73.

I have also enclosed a copy of the present list of Governors' designees, containing your address and telephone number. If any information on this list is inaccurate, please send your corrections to the Office of State and Tribal Programs. If we do not receive a response by May 31, 2002, we will assume the information shown on the list is correct. The list of Governors' designees is required to be published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on or about June 30, 2002.

During the year, please inform us of any changes which may arise in either appointment, address, or telephone number. Please note that changes in <u>appointment</u> should be made by the Governor of your State.

On January 6, 1982 (47 FR 596 and 47 FR 600), the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) published in the Federal Register final amendments to 10 CFR Parts 71 and 73 (effective July 6, 1982), that require advance notification to Governors or their designees by NRC licensees prior to transportation of certain shipments of nuclear waste and spent fuel. The advance notification covered in Part 73 is for spent nuclear reactor fuel shipments and the notification for Part 71 is for large quantity shipments of radioactive waste (and of spent nuclear reactor fuel not covered under the final amendment to 10 CFR Part 73).

The following list updates the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of those individuals in each State who are responsible for receiving information on nuclear waste shipments. The list will be published annually in the Federal Register on or about June 30 to reflect any changes in information.
