Describe Follow-up: (Telephone, Internet, Chamber of Commerce, Other) <b>Visited the Mining Health Safety and Training (MSH&amp;T) office in Fairmont, WV, and spoke to Brian Mills, an inspector (304) 367-2706. Mr. Mills told NRC inspectors that the name of the plant was "Dents" Run, not "Bents" Run. Mr. Mills also stated that the plant was inactive and told inspectors to contact Gary Fluharty, who oversaw the grounds and equipment that was left at the mine. The inspectors visited the mine site on Oct. 24, 2002, and found that the plant was empty except for a security guard. The guard contacted Gary Fluharty, who contacted the corporate RSO, Joe Richards. Mr. Richards said that the plant was inactive and was filled with methane gas. Mr Richards stated that no nuclear devices were on site at the Dents Run Plant, and sent transfer records to show this. According to Mr. Richards and the transfer reports (see attached), all of the nuclear gauges used at the Dent's Run plant were removed in June of 1998 and placed in temporary storage at a Consol facility in Pennsylvania. In February of 1999, these devices were then disposed of appropriately. All transfers were performed by vendors authorized to do such work.</b>
