In response to Jeanne Schauble's October 1, 2002, letter requesting the permanent transfer of 112 cubic feet of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) records currently stored at the Washington National Record Center (WNRC) in Suitland, Maryland, to your facility in College Park, Maryland, we have annotated the attached RG 431 to indicate 43 cubic feet of records that cannot be transferred at this time.
