Packaging Technology, Inc. (PacTec) hereby submits this application for a Certificate of Compliance (C of C) for the SteriGenics Eagle Cask (SEC). Included within this application are ten sets of Revision 0 of the SEC Safety Analysis Report (SAR). We request that the C of C be issued to Packaging Technology, Inc.

The SEC is a transportation package designed to safely transport Cobalt-60 special form capsules. Our customer, SteriGenics International, commissioned PacTec to design this new package with the intent of servicing the radiation processing industry. Currently, there is no transportation package available for this application which possesses an NRC-approval to the current 10 CFR 71 regulations. SteriGenics, as the largest single user of Cobalt-60 special form capsules in the world, believes that this new transportation package will offer this industry and the NRC a transportation package which will ensure the continued safe transportation of this material for the next millennium.
