Per 10 CFR 32.52 (or equivalent Agreement State regulations), you are only required to report devices transfers to a General Licensee within a state to the proper regulatory authority for that state. Also, you are required to report no distribution of devices within a jurisdiction for a quarter (null report) to that regulatory authority. Specifically, devices distributed (or no distribution for the quarter) to Ohio, need only be reported to Ohio, and devices transferred to Texas need only be reported to Texas. Any distribution (or lack thereof) to non-Agreement States is reported to the NRC. Your package contained considerably more information than the NRC needed. I also see that you indicated on the letters to the states, that you CC'd US NRC on their letters.

This e-mail is to inform you that you do not need to copy the NRC on these reports. Based on my review of the package, it appears that you intended to report to NRC that you made distribution to Ohio in the third quarter of 2002. Since Ohio is an Agreement State, we will consider your letter as notification that there were no deliveries made to General Licensees in states which are not Agreement States (i.e. 'NRC' states). Also, please update the address you send your reports to. Per 10 CFR 32.52, General License reports only need to be sent to NRC Headquarters. Through the document system, all reports are available to all NRC staff at Headquarters and the Regional offices.
