Kaiser Aluminum & Chemical Corporation (Kaiser Aluminum) appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on NRC's Proposed Rule; Transfers of Certain Source Materials by Specific Licensees.

Kaiser Aluminum is a fully integrated manufacturer of aluminum and aluminum products. Kaiser Aluminum is currently working with NRC under the Site Decommissioning Management Plan (SDMP) to decommission a previously licensed facility in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Successful completion of this project is dependant on availability of waste disposal options.

Kaiser Aluminum supports NRC's proposed change to section 40.13 (a) to clarify the exemption applies to disposal. The proposed amendment to section 40.51 will provide assurance that transfers of exempt material will not adversely affect human health.
