Mr. Edwards:

This acknowledges receipt of your Initial NRC Form 241 dated October 8, 2002, and the \$1400 application fee, submitted to the NRC Region IV office to report proposed activities in NRC jurisdiction under the authority of the general license pursuant to 10 CFR 150.20. Your agreement state license is recognized as valid for the proposed use of licensed material. An approval letter will be forthcoming with an assigned reciprocity tracking system number for the respective work location. You may use the NRC signed NRC Form 241 to start your work activities.

The NRC approval for proposed reciprocity activities in NRC jurisdiction under the authority of the general license pursuant to 10 CFR 150.20, is for each calendar year. However, on your Initial NRC Form 241 dated October 8, 2002, you requested work dates which extended through March 11, 2003. We will not be able to grant reciprocity through this date. Your approval will only be granted through December 31, 2002.

If you require reciprocity for CY 2003, then you must submit an Initial NRC Form 241, "Report of Proposed Activities in Non-Agreement States, Areas of Exclusive Federal Jurisdiction, or Offshore Waters," 4 copies of your Agreement State specific license, and the fee specified in fee Category 16, 10 CFR 170.31 (currently \$1400). This filing must be made to the NRC for the first time in any calendar year that such activities are to occur.
