Millstone Power Station, Unit No. 1
Completion of Items for the May 23, 2002, Order for Interim
Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures

On May 23, 2002, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an Order for Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures (the Order) to all decommissioning nuclear power plants with spent fuel in the spent fuel pool located inside an operating reactor protected area. Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DNC) answered this Order, which applies to Millstone Unit No. 1, by letter dated June 12, 2002 (B18673).

DNC's response to Interim Compensatory Measure (ICM) B.1.b in the June 12, 2002, letter required, in-part, that DNC provide the NRC with additional information on the results of an engineering evaluation (see Attachment 1). It has been determined that no additional mitigative measures, beyond those already put in place in response to the Unit Nos. 2 and 3 Order, as described in a letter dated July 18, 2002 (B18719), are required as a result of the Unit No. 1 engineering evaluation.

Attachment 1 to this letter contains Safeguards Information as defined by 10 CFR 73.21 and its disclosure to unauthorized individuals is prohibited by Section 147 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

The Millstone Power Station is in compliance with the conditions of the May 23, 2002, Order. Our actions to comply with the Order are described within this letter and the June 12, 2002, letter answering this Order.

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
