NRC STAFF RESPONSE TO
OCTOBER 24, 2002 MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

On October 24, 2002, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel (hereinafter "Board") issued a Memorandum and Order in which it requested the parties to respond to three issues. First, the Board requested the parties to review the List of Exhibits for accuracy. Second, the Board requested that the parties inform the Board of any necessary changes or corrections to the hearing transcript. Finally, the Board requested further briefing on the Motion to Compel filed by the Tennessee Valley Authority (hereinafter "TVA") on August 22, 2002 requesting that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (hereinafter "NRC") Staff pay additional travel expenses to Wilson C. McArthur for his hearing testimony.

Under this agreement, TVA will withdraw its Motion to Compel in return for the Staff agreeing to reimburse travel expenses related to Dr. McArthur's deposition in December 2001.
