In accordance with Section G.4, Task Order Procedures, of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Modification No. 2 to Task Order No. 3 which: (1) provides for additional within scope changes to the Statement of Work to allow the contractor to prepare for and participate in a second ACRS briefing and a public meeting, and to modify the cost analysis, if necessary, based on comments received at the ACRS and/or public meeting. All work shall be performed in accordance with the contractor's technical proposal dated October 22, 2002, and (2) increases the obligated and ceiling amounts of the task order by \$14,510.00 from \$56,785.00 to \$71,295.00. Accordingly, the task order is hereby revised as follows:

The second paragraph of the definitization letter of the basic task order is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

"Task Order No. 3 shall be in effect from March 18, 2002 through December 31, 2002, with a cost ceiling of \$71,295.00. The amount of \$66,322.00 represents the total estimated reimbursable cost, and the amount of \$4,973.00 represents the fixed fee."

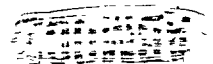




