Dear Mr. Stewart-Smith:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) revised the enclosed subject plan and submitted it to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for concurrence. The revised plan incorporates the riprap size testing procedure accepted by NRC and an engineering evaluation of minimum riprap size, expressed as median diameter (D_{50}). The evaluation, using current NRC procedures, indicates the minimum D_{50} is 1.8 inches. The design minimum D_{50} was 2.7 inches. The DOE attached the evaluation to the plan

The DOE made other general format changes to the plan to make it consistent with other plans currently produced for DOE sites. These format changes did not entail changes to technical content or stewardship requirements.
