Resolution of the issues in the Reactor Generic Issue Program continues to be on track in accordance with the schedules previously submitted to you. The most significant developments over the past four weeks were two presentations by the staff of its technical assessment of Generic Safety Issue 189, "Susceptibility of Ice Condenser and MARK III Containments to Hydrogen Combustion During A Severe Accident," at: (1) a joint meeting of the ACRS Subcommittee on Thermal-Hydraulic Phenomena and Reliability and the ACRS Subcommittee on Probabilistic Assessment, on November 5, 2002; and (2) the 497th Meeting of the ACRS on November 7, 2002. No issues were resolved over the past four weeks and the monthly status report to Congress should state that there is no change in this area from the October 2002 report.
