SUBJECT: ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE CONFIRMATION

Dear Mr. Maimone:

The conclusions of an NRC Office of Investigations (OI) investigation and the NRC's intention to take enforcement action against you individually were described in a letter to you dated November 5, 2002. This letter also stated that the NRC has significant information concerning the apparent violations, and that it may not be necessary to conduct a predecisional enforcement conference in order to enable the NRC to make an enforcement decision. The letter also provided you an opportunity to either (1) respond, in writing, to the apparent violations addressed in the summary within 30 days of the date of that letter or (2) request a predecisional enforcement conference. On November 20, 2002, you contacted the NRC and requested an enforcement conference.

This letter is to inform you that the conference will take place at 10:00 a.m. on December 12, 2002, at the Region I office, King of Prussia, PA. This conference will be closed for public observation and will be transcribed.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm.html (the Electronic Reading Room). However, the NRC will not make a copy of this letter available to the public until an enforcement decision has been made. At that time, in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter, with your home address removed, will be made available to the public, if enforcement action is taken. A summary of the investigation was provided with our letter dated November 5, 2002 and has been placed in ADAMS and is available to the public.
