Having attended the community forum, October 14 on the proposed uranium enrichment plant for Hartsville, TN, I was left with two grave concerns:

1. That the tails not remain in Trousdale County or the area for more than thirty (30) days. This indicates that LES must have plans to move them to a suitable place before approval for construction is granted

2. That Mr. Doug Collins of NRC Region II, Atlanta, GA, indicated that after a few years of rigid inspections your agency will pretty much back off and quit inspections, rather than have continued rigid inspections.

We are trying to have an open mind concerning the plant, but it is hard to remain open minded when our government is indicating it is lax in inspections and rules.
