Desc: I would like to request information regarding the Gamma Industries site (AKA Cumberland Research) located in Port Norris, NJ. I am interested in obtaining copies of ALL surveys especially the report prepared by T.J. Vitkus entitled "Radiological Survey of the Former Gamma Industries Site, Port Norris, NJ" (Sept 1996). I would also like to request a reason for decision explanation regarding the environmental safety and/or impact of substances stored on this property and the "no stipulation" ruling on the disposal of the structure (building) that manufactured these substances (i.e. copies of reports that your decisions were based on).

Expedite\_ImminentThreatText: I live [REDACTED] from this former radiation lab and have concerns about our drinking water due to the fact that these dangerous substances were buried for 15 years prior to removal.

Waiver\_Purpose: I intend to have my water tested for the substances that were manufactured at the lab.

Waiver\_ExtentToExtractAnalyze: I plan to learn more about the substances used and to determine the impact of these toxins in the environment in which I reside.

Waiver\_SpecificActivityQuals: My research into the disposal and/or storage of substances on this property will assure me that the environment and private wells are clear of toxins.

Waiver\_ImpactPublicUnderstanding: The residents of Port Norris that I have spoken with have no idea what was manufactured on this property and how it was disposed of. It is rumored that substances are still buried there. I am awaiting EPA documentation regarding disposal and nature of the substances.

Waiver\_NatureOfPublic: Port Norris is a small town of approximately 1500 people located in Cumberland

county NJ.

Waiver\_MeansOfDissemination: Because this is a personal concern, relaying info to the general public is not being considered until documents have been received and the urgency of release of any information has been determined.

Waiver\_FreeToPublicOrFee: If the environment is found to be unsafe or safe, this information would be free of charge.

Waiver\_PrivateCommericalInterest: As I stated earlier, I am concerned about the environmental impact and safety of my drinking water as a result of substances stored on the property and the close proximity of this lab to my home. It is expected that the water tests for radiation and heavy metals will cost me hundreds of dollars.
