DESCRIPTION OF EVENT Several individuals were in possession of radioactive materials without authorization. The materials were seized as by Suffolk police, BNL packaged the materials for transport to SUNY Stony Brook for secure/safe storage pending resolution of criminal charges against the individuals in possession of the materials. These persons have been charged with conspiracy, they planned to use the RAM to contaminate public officials.

FOLLOW-UP

The police are continuing their investigation. DOH BERP staff went to Stony Brook to get a better idea of the types and quantities of RAM. An inventory list was produced. BNL and Suffolk Co. staff performed surveys the vehicles and residences involved. BERP staff surveyed a residence in Nassau Co.

OUTCOME

The material is being stored at DOH licensee's facility pending the trial. DOH has contacted the CRCPD to see someone has expressed the need for Ra-226. One source greater than the maximum allowable for disposal at this time. It appears that the individuals did not use the materials as planned. The incident is closed out for purposes of protecting public health, but the disposal issue will need to be resolved in the future.
