#### SYNPOSIS

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region II, initiated this investigation on May 31, 2001, to determine whether a training instructor at the Florida Power and Light Company's Turkey Point Nuclear Plant was terminated as a result of reporting safety concerns.

Based on the evidence developed and contact with the Regional Counsel, there does not appear to be a prima facie case of retaliation in view of the fact that the alleger's termination was not connected to his protected activity of raising safety concerns.
