Alan Roecklein:

I am surprised that my request was (is) so confusing. I have all of the documents that you have listed and I have received the package dated November 12, 2002, from Michael Lesar in addition to tracking all of those comments as they have appeared on the NRC's rulemaking web page.

Alan, you are listed as the technical contact in the letter that I have received from Michael Lesar. Accordingly, in my e-mail to you on November 19 I stated:

As you know, Westinghouse believes that the "...proposed revisions...are unnecessary." In support of its position, Westinghouse states the following in the first line of the last paragraph of the second page of its attachment to its October 22, 2002, letter, LTR-NRC-02-53: More recently, Westinghouse conducted tests with pure oxygen as the oxidant instead of steam.

Now I will reword my request: As the technical contact on PRM-50-76 are you aware of any documents that Westinghouse has submitted to the NRC that describe its work on "...tests with pure oxygen as the oxidant instead of steam." So, please answer my question. And if the NRC has those documents, please tell me when they will become available in the NRC's PDR.

You are identified as the technical contact in Lesar's letter of November 12, 2002, and my inquiry is the sort of matter that a technical contact should be able and required to answer in a straightforward manner.
