SUBJECT: STOLEN PORTABLE GAUGE

DESCRIPTION:

On November 27, 2002, the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (the Department) notified NRC's Operations Center of the reported theft of a portable moisture/density gauge.

On November 20, 2002, the Department received telephone notification of the theft of the gauge from Soils and Materials Consultants, Inc., a Colorado licensee. The licensee provided written notification on November 25, 2002. The licensee reported that the gauge had been stolen on November 20, 2002, from the back of a camper truck while parked at a Walmart located in Brighton, Colorado. The gauge was locked in its transportation case, but not secured to the bed of the truck. However, the camper shell was locked. The operator reported that the camper shell was pried open, and the gauge and transportation case were missing from the truck. The gauge is a CPN International Inc. Model MC1-DR (Serial No. MD 80804445), containing a 0.37 gigabequerel (10 millicurie) source of cesium-137 and a 1.85 gigabequerel (50 millicurie) source of americium-241:beryllium. The licensee promptly notified the local police. The Department is continuing to investigate this event.

Region IV received notification of this occurrence by phone from the Department at 11:15 a.m. (CST) on November 27, 2002. Region IV has informed the OEDO, NMSS, OSTP, IAT, and the Region's PAO and SLO.

This information has been discussed with the State and is current as of 10:00 a.m. on November 27, 2002.
