Dear Mr. Travers:

On November 7, 2002, the State filed a request with the Licensing Board to obtain access, under a protective order, to Attachment 2 of a Commission Order dated October 23, 2002. Attachment 2 of the Order, issued to certain licensees who currently store or have near term plans to store spent fuel in an ISFSI under a Part 72 specific license, relates to interim safety measures those licensee must take. The Commission considered Attachment 2 to be safeguards material and did not release it to the public.

To the extent that the State is required to make a demand on you for production of Attachment 2 of the Commission's October 23, 2002 Order, the State hereby makes that request for the reasons specified in "State of Utah's Motion for Production of Commission Order Relating to Safeguards Under a Protective Order and For Opportunity to File Contentions," filed with the Licensing Board in the PFS proceeding (Docket 72-22) on November 7, 2002, a copy of which is attached hereto.
