SUBJECT: Opportunity for Collaborative Assessments

FEMA will be sponsoring a National Emergency Management Baseline - Capability Assessment Program during fiscal years 2003 and 2004. This enterprise will be conducted using the Emergency Management Accreditation Program standard and assessment strategy. The process will involve, for each state and territory, a comprehensive self-assessment followed by a thorough, rigorous on-site assessment conducted by a credentialed assessment team comprised of experienced emergency managers. These state-by-state assessments will give us a reliable and defensible national baseline of our current capabilities to prepare for, respond to and recover from emergencies and disasters. We plan to begin actual on-site assessments in January 2003.

During the recent National Emergency Management Association Conference, state representatives were unanimous in their appeal that we try to unify this program, and assessment schedule, with any other assessment activities being planned or contemplated by other federal agencies. Toward that end, if your agency, or organizations therein, is planning or contemplating any self-assessment or on-site assessments of state emergency response capabilities within your functional areas of concern, we would like to offer you the opportunity to synchronize those assessment requirements/visits with our National Emergency Management Baseline - Capability Assessment Program schedule. Let me emphasize that this is not a proposal to merge our respective assessment programs, merely an attempt to synchronize their delivery to reduce the burden on the states of supporting and hosting a potential succession of assessment teams and activities.
