SYNOPSIS

The Office of Investigations (OI), U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Region II (RII), initiated this investigation on August 23, 2001, to determine whether a Florida Power and Light Company, St. Lucie Plant (SLP) protective services manager manipulated the random drug screening process to improperly select an instrumentation and control (I&C) specialist to undergo a random drug screening examination.

Based on the evidence developed, testimony, and an observation of the drug screening process, the allegation that the SLP protective services manager manipulated the random drug screening process to improperly select an I&C specialist to undergo a random drug screening examination was not substantiated.
