NRC staff has informed my office that NRC has no record of a license issued to NEN Biosciences, which you indicated was located on Albany Street in Boston, Massachusetts. However, they were able to identify two retired licenses that were issued to companies with a somewhat similar name in the state of Massachusetts: Docket No. 030-09374, E.I. du Pont de Nemours & Co., NEN Products, and Docket No. 030-28902, E. I. du Pont de Nemours & Co., NEN Life Science Products. Since the State of Massachusetts participates in NRC's Agreement States Program, you would need to contact the Massachusetts Agreement State Director (Robert M. Hallisey, Director, Radiation Control Program, Department of Public Health, 174 Portland Street, 5th Floor, Boston, MA 02114) for any records related to these retired licenses.

In addition to the above, staff located an active license, Docket No. 030-09023, License No. 20-00320-14E, Perkin Elmer Life Sciences, formerly named NEN Life Sciences Products, Inc., at 549 Albany Street, Boston, Massachusetts. As a courtesy, we are enclosing a copy of the most recent Safety and Compliance Inspection report for this license, dated January 27, 1999. If you wish additional information on this licensee you will need to submit a new Freedom of Information Act request to the NRC.
