The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will hold a public meeting Tuesday, August 27 from 7 00 p m to 10 30 p m to provide information to the public on the "Draft Safety Evaluation Report on the Construction Authorization Request for the Mixed Oxide Fuel Fabrication Facility," dated April 30, and NRC's process and schedule for future reviews concerning the Construction Authorization Request (CAR). The CAR, submitted by Duke Cogema Stone and Webster, pertains to a proposed Mixed Oxide Fuel Fabrication Facility (MFFF) which would be constructed on the Department of Energy's Savannah River Site.
