Dear Ms. Cleveland:

Please find enclosed a letter from Dr. Carol Marcus to Chairman Meserve dated October 24, 2002, in which she proposes the development of a comprehensive list of specific gamma ray dose constants for adults and children of different body builds for a variety of radionuclides. Dr. Marcus proposes the development of this list for use by medical emergency response teams as a triage tool to identify and segregate victims with significant internal contamination.

In our view, Dr. Marcus' suggestion addresses an emergency response issue that falls within the responsibility of the Federal Radiological Preparedness Coordinating Committee. In that connection, we understand that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention is chairing a multi-agency Workgroup that was recently formed to identify tasks that need to be addressed in the area of radiological response. As we understand that this Workgroup is addressing the issue of screening potentially contaminated individuals in such a situation, we are forwarding Dr. Marcus' letter to you for your consideration.
