Dear Mr. Klapproth:

The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of licensing topical report NEDE-32906P, Supplement 1, "TRACG Application for Anticipated Transient Without SCRAM Overpressure Transient." We have found that the material presented is sufficient to begin our comprehensive review. The staff expects to issue requests for additional information by February 2003, and complete its review by August 30, 2003. The staff estimates that the review will require approximately 500 staff hours.

Section 170.21 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* requires that topical reports are subject to fees based on the full cost of the review. You did not request a fee waiver; therefore, staff hours will be billed accordingly. To enable us to complete this review on schedule, close and frequent communications between our technical staffs will be required.
