## REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE REVIEW OF THE PEACH BOTTOM ATOMIC POWER STATION, UNITS 2 AND 3 LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION

The purpose of this letter is to submit annual cost and revenue information for PSEG Nuclear in support of the application to renew the operating licenses for the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, Units 2 and 3, submitted by letter dated July 2, 2001.

  - ii. This information is of a type that is held in confidence by PSEG, and there is a rational basis for doing so because the information contains sensitive financial information concerning PSEG's projected revenues and operating expenses.
  - iii. The information is being transmitted to the NRC in confidence.
  - iv. This information is not available in public sources and could not be gathered readily from other publicly available information.
