**Subject:** SNM Exemption Order

Mr. Tim Harris,

As per our telephone conversation earlier this morning, Envirocare would like to revise the scope of the NRC's review of SNM in liquids for solidification. Envirocare specified a maximum volume in the original request to amend the SNM Exemption Order of 400 gallons but since then generators have shown a demand to ship in containers with higher volumes, approximately a factor of ten higher than the requested 400 gallons. During our conversation you stated that the NRC is considering limiting the SNM in liquid shipments to a total mass instead of a concentration. Therefore, Envirocare requests that shipment volumes not be limited as long as the NRC-determined SNM mass limits are not exceeded.
