1           Keker & Van Nest, L.L.P. (the "Firm") submits its Cover Sheet Application (the

3 Expenses for the Period November 1, 2002 to November 30, 2002 (the "Application Period").

4 In support of the Application, the Firm respectfully represents as follows:

5           1.       The Firm is special counsel to Pacific Gas and Electric Company, the debtor in  
6 possession in the above-referenced bankruptcy case (the "Debtor"). The Firm hereby applies to  
7 the Court for allowance and payment of interim compensation for services rendered and  
8 reimbursement of expenses incurred during the Application Period.

21           5.       To date, the Firm is owed as follows (excluding amounts owed pursuant to this  
22 Application): \$16,490.35 (plus the pre-petition amount of \$23,879.70).

23           6.       With regard to the copies of this Application served on counsel for the  
24 Committee, counsel for the Debtor and the Office of the United States Trustee, (a) attached as  
25 Exhibit 1 hereto is the name of each professional who performed services in connection with this  
26 case during the period covered by this Application and the hourly rate for each such professional;

1 and (b) attached as Exhibit 2 is an Account Summary. The detailed time and expense statements  
2 for the Application Period that comply with all Northern District of California Bankruptcy Local  
3 Rules and Compensation Guidelines and the Guidelines of the Office of the United States  
4 Trustee have been submitted in electronic form to the Office of the United States Trustee,  
5 Federal Expressed overnight to counsel for the Committee, and hand-delivered to the Debtor.

6 7. The Firm will serve a copy of this Application on the Special Notice List in this  
7 case on December 30, 2002.

8 8. Pursuant to this Court's "ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERIM FEE  
9 APPLICATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE" which was entered on  
10 or about July 26, 2001, and the "AMENDED ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERIM FEE  
11 APPLICATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT" which was entered on or about  
12 November 8, 2001, the Debtor is authorized to make the payment requested herein without a  
13 further hearing or order of this Court unless an objection to this Application is filed with the  
14 Court by the Debtor, the Committee or the United States Trustee and served by the fifteenth day  
15 of the month following the service of this Application. If such an objection is filed, Debtor is  
16 authorized to pay the amounts, if any, not subject to the objection. The Firm is informed and  
17 believes that this Cover Sheet Application will be mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, on  
18 or about December 30, 2002.

19 9. The interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses sought in this  
20 Application is on account and is not final. Upon the conclusion of these cases, the Firm will seek  
21 fees and reimbursement of the expenses incurred for the totality of the services rendered in this  
22 case. Any interim fees or reimbursement of expenses approved by this Court and received by the  
23 Firm (along with the Firm's retainer) will be credited against such final fees and expenses as may  
24 be allowed by this Court.

25 WHEREFORE, the Firm respectfully requests that the Debtor pay compensation to the  
26 Firm as requested herein pursuant to and in accordance with the terms of the "ORDER
