Tim,

The report looks fine. The only treatment system that we recall talking about that could concentrate waste was thermal desorption and vitrification, both of which we are only investigating and have decided not to include in the exemption.

Each mixing bin is 40 cubic yards and there are two separate bins, only one of which we are currently using in the permacon. We will go with the 0.1% Beryllium limit since it is in the regulation and it is all we think we will need.

We will start working on the action items and forward to ASAP.
