What is NRCareers?

NRCareers is a web-based vacancy announcement and job application system that enables you to view job vacancies at the NRC and easily apply online. NRCareers is faster, easier, and more convenient than the traditional employment and response method. Imagine, instead of preparing multiple copies of your application package and rushing to ensure its delivery before the deadline, you'll be able to prepare your entire application package online. And because NRCareers relies on e-mail to keep you up-to-date on the status of your application, we'll be able to respond to you in a more timely fashion.

How do I get connected?

All you need is a computer with web access. You can connect 7 days a week, 24 hours a day from the privacy of your home, from the local library – virtually anywhere. It takes no time at all to connect to NRCareers. Just point your browser and you're there. To enter your resume you can either type it directly in to NRCareers or you can copy and paste it from any word processing or resume program.

Let NRCareers do even more work for you.

NRCareers has many features for you. For instance, once you enter your resume in the system, it will be stored electronically, available to you whenever you want to apply

to a new vacancy. You can also elect to have NRCareers notify you automatically, via e-mail, when new vacancies occur.
