FOIA REQUEST

Dear FOI Officer:

Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. s. 552, I request access to and copies of all lesson learned reports for mock attacks under the Operational Safeguards Response Evaluation Program carried out at Three Mile Island in Dauphin County, Pa. and Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station in York County, Pa. between 1990 and 2002.

I agree to pay reasonable duplication fees for the processing of this request in an amount not to exceed \$50. However, please notify me prior to your incurring any expenses in excess of that amount.

As a representative of the news media I am only required to pay for the direct cost of duplication after the first 100 pages.

Through this request, I am gathering information on records concerning the mock attack reports that is of current interest to the public because Unitas was inducted into the National Football League Hall of Fame and recognized as a public figure.

This information is being sought on behalf of York Daily Record for dissemination to the general public.

Please waive any applicable fees. Release of the information is in the public interest because it will contribute significantly to public understanding of government operations and activities.

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees.

As I am making this request as a journalist and this information is of timely value, I would appreciate your communicating with me by telephone, rather than by mail, if you have questions regarding this request.

Please provide expedited review of this request which concerns a matter of urgency. As a journalist, I am primarily engaged in disseminating information.

The public has an urgent need for this information concerning the mock attack reports. The records may involve an impending decision to which informed members of the public might contribute through lobbying or other contacts with public officials and in these instances delay would simply rob the public of its ability to make known its views in a timely manner.

I certify that my statements concerning the need for expedited review are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
