Trip says that Stu Treby said that Gary Mizuno had visit from Exelon who dropped off two "position" papers for review and comment.

One deals with the interpretation of Price Anderson Act which is up for renewal this year and sets the indemnity based on a 100 mw facility and they will have 10 units each of 100 mw for a total of 1000 mw and don't want to have to pay Price Anderson 10 times the damages if there is an accident OGC will deal with this issue

Second issue, they don't want to pay 10 annual fees. I told Trip that is an issue with how NRR is going to issue the license Is it one license with 10 units or is it 10 separate licenses

(Or, do we have to come up with a new multi-unit annual fee for power reactors to accommodate Pebble Bed technology I have no idea at this point)
