However, he wishes a pre-meet this week with NRR/OGC and has the following questions which he would like answered this week and certainly BEFORE he goes to the 6/12 meeting.

1. Is the white paper accurate in its analysis?

- A The PBMR modules at a site will have a single licensing basis.
- B The PBMR design will be simpler and safer than PWR and BWR.
- C. Will require less oversight.

2. Need discussion on:

- A How many PBMR sites are envisioned over what period of time
- B Talk about 10 modules (1500 MWe) Is this the max?
What would average site be? If they have 10 moduels is the concept that they would always operate 10 or is part of this reserve capacity?
- C. What is the vision on licensing? Approve 5 modules, then some time later a 6th or a 7th? New license? Mod to license? Approve all 10 as a concept?
- D Will a "site" of 10 modules of PBMR retain the same "site" definition of a site for BWR or PWR?
- E. Timeframe for licensing? Timeframe for building? When do we expect the first to be operational?
- F. Will they also have a resident?
- G Will Regional and HQS inspection activity (number and length) be the same for a PWR and PWR and PBMR?
