Mr. Rubin:

Diane Dandois (OCFO/DAF/LFARB) and I have reviewed your first draft and have a couple of initial clarifying comments:

- The reimbursable agreement with DOE for Phase I would be made under the authority of the Economy Act (or perhaps NRC's cooperative research authority if approved by Brian Kildee), while the charging of fees to Exelon in Phase II would be under the authority of 10 CFR 170.

- We suggest that the resource levels be noted separately for Phase I (reimbursable from DOE) and Phase II (funded from NRC's fee-based appropriations).

These represent our individual comments at this time and do not represent overall OCFO comments.
