This is in response to your FOIA request, dated 20 Nov 01, for a copy of the AIB investigation involving an FY 91, F-16 mishap out of Moody AFB, in which the pilot allegedly sustained a G-Induced Loss of Consciousness. Your request was forwarded to 9AF at Shaw AFB, SC for action since that command would have convened an AIB investigation involving an F-16 aircraft out of Moody AFB. I have been informed that they have no record of such an incident or investigation. They will provide you with a written no records response.

In addition, I requested a listing of all F-16 Class A mishaps out of Moody AFB during the period FY90, FY91, and FY92 from the Air Force Safety Center at Kirtland AFB. There were three such incidents: 25 May 90, 19 Sep 90 and 4 Apr 91. None of these mishaps involved G-Induced Loss of Consciousness. A check was also made of all F-16 G-Lock incidents for all classes of mishaps for this same period of time. There is no record of any G-Lock incidents involving Moody F-16 aircraft, nor any other F-16 mishaps that occurred on or near Moody AFB, GA, during this time that involved G-Induced Loss of Consciousness.

The Air Force thus has no records responsive to your request.
