Dear Mr. Collins:

We are pleased to report that Framatome ANP (formerly Siemens Power Corporation (SPC)) has completed all of the commitments made in Reference 1, which responded to the NRC's 1997 engineering inspection at our Richland facility. All except two of the 38 commitments were completed by the end of 1999. The two remaining commitments, summarized below, were completed in December 2001.

#24: Review and update the Verification and Validation (V&V) and user's manuals for SPC's primary codes.

#25: Update or create theory manuals and programmer's manuals for SPC's primary codes.

Details of the implementation process resulting from the completion of these commitments are being provided to Mr. J. S. Wermiel.

Originally, these commitments were scheduled for completion in 2002 (#24) and 2005 (#25). As explained in Reference 2, numerous schedule and priority adjustments were made so that these important activities could be completed in 2001 and 2002. Both commitments were actually completed by the end of 2001.

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
