Your concerns related to environmental justice, transportation of radioactive materials, the need for the facility, and foreign ownership. Each of these concerns are areas that will be evaluated in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) review of the LES application. NRC will also prepare an environmental impact statement for the project.

We would like to point out that the public will have several opportunities to formally participate in the LES licensing process. For example, after LES submits its license application and environmental report to the NRC, the public will have an opportunity to petition for a hearing. In addition, the public will have an opportunity to provide information in the NRC's environmental impact statement (EIS) scoping process and to comment on NRC's draft EIS. Our intent is to give the public an opportunity to participate in the formal licensing process. In addition, meetings between the staff and LES have been and will continue to be noticed and the public may attend meetings in accordance with the Commission's policy on public meetings.
