Dear Mr. Rivera

The following information is submitted in response to your letter dated November 05, 2002:

- By "source" I am referring to the four sealed source models contained in the registry. The instruments that these sources were assembled into, two models of gas chromatographs, were discontinued 8 years ago. Subsequently, sales of these sealed sources has been limited to replacement service usage.
- I am requesting that all four models, N600-0113, N600-0030, L413-0127 and L413-0128 be inactivated.
- Approximately 1000 units were distributed to US customers; of these we estimate that up to 20%, 200 units, may still be in use today.
- Gas Chromatographs will continue to be serviced by our Service Department. The sealed sources within these chromatographs will be serviced by our supplier, NRD located in Grand Island, NY.
- No changes have been made to the product since the last certificate amendment.
- The products listed in the registry will not be manufactured or distributed after Dec 31, 2002.
- Requested letters enclosed (it should be noted that the 18 attachments for the June 5, 1995 letter were not included – these attachments reflected devices not currently part of the subject registry)
