CONDITIONS (continued from page 1)

12. A. The only person authorized to act as a radiographer under this license is John K. Meham.
- B. The only persons authorized to act as an assistant radiographer under this license is Christopher J. Kiana.
13. The licensee is authorized to receive, possess and use sources of Iridium-192 where the activity exceeds the maximum amount of radioactivity specified in Item 8 of this license provided:
- A. Such possession does not exceed the quantity per source specified in Item 8 by more than 20% for Ir-192.
- B. Records of the licensee show that no more than the maximum amount of radioactivity per source specified in Item 8 of the license was ordered from the supplier or transferor of the radioactive material and
- C. The levels of radiation for radiographic exposure devices and storage containers do not exceed those specified in Section D.101 of Idaho Radiation Control Regulations.
14. The licensee is authorized to possess, use, and transfer, up to 450 kilograms of uranium contained as shielding material in the radiography exposure devices and source changers authorized by this license.
15. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Idaho Radiation Control Regulations, Part C, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation", and Part D, "Radiation Safety Requirements for Industrial Radiographic Operations."
16. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use radioactive material described in Items 6, 7 and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in the following documents:
- A. Application letter and "Operational and Emergency Procedures" and "Management Program" dated July 29, 1978 from John K. Meham.
