I spoke to Bill Gleaves re the FLIRA paper. The resources that are included in FCSS for Pebble Bed are in the FCSS program, however, they are for the overall office effort. Per Bill Gleaves, the paper has been worked on with other Divisions since about March 2001. The resources are all rolled up at the aggregate and they do not exceed the 1 FTE that included in the budget for Pebble Bed. In the narrative of the paper, it discusses other activities, which Bill does not view as future licensing activities, but they are a part of the normal work that would be done to complete effort, and is already covered in the budget as part of the regular workload. Bill Gleaves and Sharon Steele have been working with NMSS/NRR folks on this effort. They have a detailed breakout of the numbers. In the proposed paper for concurrence, they're at the gross totals. He's leaving early today and needs concurrence soon.

It seems reasonable.
