In response to our discussions regarding the remaining information needed to renew the above referenced permits for the Grants project, enclosed please find a copy of the Grants Project cost estimate that was recently provided to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The cost estimate spreadsheets were used to determine the amount of performance quarantee that is required to be posted for the site; the associated company quarantee documentation has been posted with the NRC.

As discussed, the cost estimate is intended to be all-inclusive for all reclamation and closure activities remaining at the project through completion of ground-water cleanup / restoration and final site closure. As such, it should include all items related to activities that would be covered or associated with renewal of DP-200 and DP-725.
