(i.e., Carolina Power & Light Company) requested relief from the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code, Section XI, in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(5)(iii) and NRC Generic Letter 90-05, "Guidance For Performing Temporary Non-Code Repair of ASME Code Class 1, 2, and 3 Piping." The request for relief related to a through-wall leak identified on Service Water System line 2-SW-29-6-046.

Restoration of the pressure boundary on line 2-SW-29-6-046, in accordance with the ASME Code, Section XI, was completed on November 15, 2002, by the installation of a replacement flange.
