LICENSEE'S ANSWER TO JANUARY 7, 2003 COMMISSION ORDER TO MODIFY LICENSE FOR COMPENSATORY MEASURES RELATED TO ACCESS AUTHORIZATION

On January 7, 2003, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC" or "Commission") issued an immediately effective order in the captioned matter entitled Order Modifying Licenses (Effective Immediately) ("Order") to, *inter alia*, Exelon Generation Company, LLC ("Exelon"). The Order stated that following September 11, 2001, the Commission took a number of actions, including the commencement of a comprehensive review of its safeguards and security programs and requirements. The Commission stated its determination that operating power reactor licensees be required to implement certain compensatory measures as prudent measures to improve access authorization. Therefore, the NRC stated it was imposing requirements as set forth in Attachment 2 of the Order. Exelon, has responded to the substantive requirements of the Order by letter dated January 27, 2003, in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.4, as directed by the Order.

Attachment 2 contained Safeguards Information and was not publicly released.

The enclosure to that letter was transmitted as Safeguards Information.

In accordance with Section IV of the Order and pursuant to 10 CFR 2.202, Exelon consents to the Order.
