465 & DNS466**


Dear Mr. Pullen:

This letter is in response to your application dated November 21, 2002, for the registration of Trilux Models TL2001, TL2002, TL2003, DNS-465 & DNS466 gun/bow sights. In reviewing the application, we find that it is lacking required information to conduct a safety evaluation. In the Enclosure to this letter, we have summarized the major issues not addressed in your application.

With incomplete documents and unavailability of adequate information the NRC Staff is unable to complete a safety evaluation of your device. Therefore, we have discontinued the review of your application. This is without prejudice to re-submission of your application. When you decide to re-submit your application for registration, please ensure that you have included the entire application with sufficient information to allow NRC to evaluate your device. Please refer to NUREG-1556 Volume 3, Chapter 10 - Contents of the Application and the Review Process, Volume 3, Appendix C - Application and Review Checklist, and Volume 8, Appendix O - Standard Requirements for Gun Sights Containing Tritium Gas Sealed in Glass Vials, for further detailed reference.
