Vectra hereby submits this application for renewal of the of the Certificate of Compliance for the Model N-55 packaging. This application consolidates all previous submittals and thus, is a complete document in itself. The quality assurance section, Section 9, has been updated to reflect the name change from Pacific Nuclear Systems to Vectra Technologies, Inc. There are no technical changes in this document from previous submittals. Enclosed are eight copies of the proprietary version and two copies of the non-proprietary version. None of the proprietary information has changed and hence the current affidavit covering that information is still effective and has not been resubmitted.

The operation procedure and the maintenance procedures for this package are current and are presently in use in the field. Packages of this design have been operated without difficulties for over fifteen years. The foam and other materials in the package have shown no appreciable deterioration over this time period. This was confirmed by destructive inspection of some packages of this approximate age within the last year.
