


- 14. The licensee shall follow Neutron Products, Inc. (NPI) Specification P-9, entitled "Procedures for Source Transfer, Maintenance, and Service Associated with Teletherapy Devices" as revised March 29, 1990. Further changes to NPI Specification P-9 which affects radiation safety must be approved by the Department prior to implementation.
- 15. All Cesium-137 sealed sources must be in dry storage.
- 16. No teletherapy unit source transfer or servicing authorized by this license shall be initiated unless the licensee has available the manufacturer's written instructions or equivalent as outlined in Neutron Product's Specification P-9 and tools for the operation, such instructions and tools being specific for each make and model of teletherapy unit and for the type of operation involved.
