Spring 2003 CAMP Meeting

Daejeon, Korea
April 28 – 30, 2003

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Spring 2003 CAMP meeting will be held from April 28 (Mon.) through April 30 (Wed.) in Daejeon, Korea. The general meeting will be held on the first two days and the TPC Meeting will be held on the morning of the third day, if necessary. Last day of the meeting (April 30) KINS will organize a technical tour to thermal-hydraulic experimental facilities on the Daeduck Science Complex.

Meetings will be held at the building of Korea Institute of Nuclear Safety (Web Site - <http://www.kins.re.kr/eng/index.asp>) (KINS). The KINS is located on the Daeduck Science Complex of Daejeon Metropolitan City.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS

Reservation in hotels Spapia(<http://www.hotelspapia.co.kr/eng/index.asp>) and Princess has been made for participants with special price. **It is highly recommended to send your registration form not later than March 29.** Late reservations will have to pay a substantially higher nightly rate.

If you want another choice we will help you to find the corresponding accommodation. Please do not hesitate to contact with us.

On the first day of the meeting (April 28) organizers will wait for you in the hotel lobby half an hour before the start of the meeting and will accompany you to the KINS. It takes 15 min. by bus from hotel to the KINS.

TRAVEL FROM THE AIRPORT

You can use the train, express bus, or airport shuttle bus to get to Daejeon (or Taejeon) from Incheon Airport (<http://www.airinfo.co.kr/Eng/home.jsp>). It takes about more than 2 hours to get to the Seoul train station or Kangnam express bus terminal from the airport by airport limousine. It takes about more than 1 1/2 hours to get to the Seoul train station or Kangnam express bus terminal by subway or taxi. From there, it takes another 2 hours to get to Daejeon by train or express bus. It is inconvenient especially for foreigners to use the train and express bus because it is necessary to reserve a train or express bus ticket especially on weekends. It is, therefore, highly recommended to use the airport city bus to get to Daejeon. It takes about 3 hours to get to Daejeon from Incheon International Airport by city bus.

Here is some information regarding the city bus from the airport to Taejeon:

- Bus Stop : Gate 8B, 1st floor
- Bus fare : 13,800 Won (US\$ 1 ~ 1,150 Won)
- Estimated travel time : about 4 hours
- Bus Service Company : Geumnam, Hanyang, Jungbu Express
- Destination(Bus NO.) : Daejeon Dongbu Terminal
- Routes : Incheon - Kimpo Airport - Seoul Belt Way - Gyeongbu/Honam Expressway - Daejeon
- Bus Stops : Kimpo Airport, {Hotel Daeduck Lotte}, {Daejeon Government Complex 3}, Daejeon Dongbu Terminal
- Departure time from Incheon airport : every hour from 04:30 AM to 6:00 PM

You can find the bus stop for Daejeon one of the bus stops bound for Provinces at the exit. It is recommended to ask for the exact location to the staff in the Tourist Information Center etc. You can get information on the Incheon International Airport at the web site.

How to get off city bus in Daejeon and get to the hotel.

1. The city bus stops twice in Daejeon before arriving at the Daejeon city Bus Terminal. Please get off the bus at the first stop (in front of Hotel Lotte Taeduk) or the second stop (in front of Government Complex 3).
2. Take a taxi and inform the taxi driver of the hotel name where you will be staying. Do not cross the street after getting off bus.
3. Taxi fare should not exceed 5,000 Won (about US\$4) from the first or second stop to a hotels in the Yuseong area. If you take a taxi from the Daejeon Inter-city Bus Terminal (Daejeon Dongbu terminal) to a hotel in the Yuseong area, taxi fare will be about 10,000 Won (about US\$8)
